El Malecón promenade Puerto Vallarta, Mexico

The newly designed Malecón promenade in the centre of Puerto Vallarta, Mexico, is an urban gem — a wooden footpath that stretches for more than one-and-a-half kilometres, from the Los Muertos beach in Viejo (Old) Vallarta in the south to the Hidalgo Park in the north. The promenade, which is adorned with bronze sculptures, attracts both young and old and local artists and other performers appear here. Awarded the accolade of “Best Urban Design Project” by Mexico’s Architectural Association, the Selux Olivio Candelabra luminaires here ensure maximum luminous intensity for locals and visitors.
